¹ In order to evaluate whether to honor a request for confidentiality or that the complaint not be pursued, the Title IX Coordinator should weigh the Complainant's request against the following factors:

- the seriousness of the alleged violation;
- the likelihood that the merits of the complaint can be substantiated;
- whether there have been other complaints of a similar nature against the same Respondent, and
- the ability of the College to investigate and remedy the complaint without disclosing the existence of the complaint or the identity of the Complainant.

² In situations where the Title IX Coordinator cannot or should not conduct the investigation, the Title IX Advisory Committee will choose the Investigator, who may be another College administrator or someone from outside the College community.
